



ROOF-TOP SAFARI TENT



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FEATURES

MATERIAL

TENT FABRIC

High quality 250gsm
Rip-stop poly-cotton fabric
UV protected, breathable,
waterproof & mould resistant

FLYSHEET

Made from Polyester 300D
with 1500mm water head
PU coating - incorporated
& attached to the tent via
steel rods & PP webbing

BASE

Aluminium Alloy on
both top & bottom
with foam insulation

MATTRESS

Comfortable 65mm
HDPE mattress
with removable cover





FAST & EASY SET UP

1. Park your vehicle on a suitable flat piece of ground
2. Remove the PVC travel cover from the tent & release the hold-down velcro straps on each side of the tent
3. Slide out the ladder until the locking pins engage
4. Pull down on the ladder, lift the top half of the tent until the two halves of the tent floor engage and remain flat
5. Rest the ladder on the ground and enter the tent. Install the spreader bars for the flysheet and window cover
6. Use the guy ropes and pegs to secure the tent

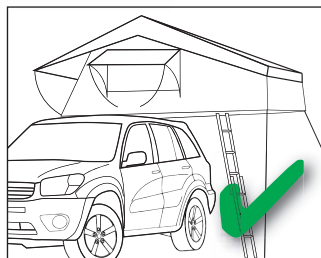
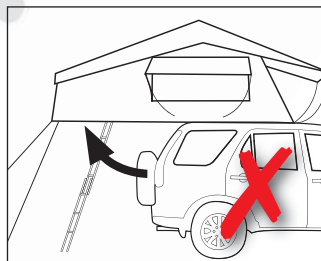
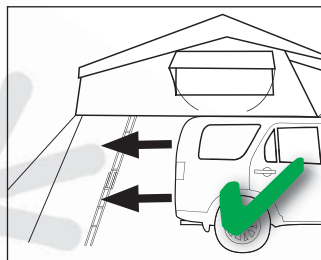

IMPORTANT

Check with your car manufacturer or dealer to make sure that the roof rack or roof bars are designed to hold a total weight of 230kg (approx.) This being the roof-top tent and two average sized adults.

TENT ORIENTATION ON YOUR VEHICLE

OFF THE BACK

For most large sized vehicles the opening "off the back" is preferable. The advantages of this orientation are:

- It leaves extra roof space for additional storage
- With the tent open you will gain weather protection above your head when accessing the back of your vehicle
- This orientation is ideally suited if you have a slot tail gate or door
- Off the back mounting is not suitable if you have a single lift tail gate, as it will severely limit your access to the rear of the vehicle

OFF THE SIDE

For most medium or small vehicles opening "off the side" is preferable. The advantages of this orientation are:

- It allows for tail-gates to operate normally
- The closed tent pack is better balanced on the roof rack and creates less wind drag



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
